

**WSVN 3.0 Multicast Signals
(Amendment to Pending Next Gen TV License Modification)**

Per newly effective FCC requirements, the attached describes the multicast signals programmed by Television Station WSVN, FCC Facility ID Number 63840, Miami, Florida (the “Station”) that are currently to appear in ATSC 3.0 on another (host) station, and which the Station requests to be licensed as part of its Next Gen TV (paired) license.

As of December 2023 and as otherwise set forth in the Station’s pending Next Gen TV license modification application (FCC File No. 0000223970) (the “Application”), each of the Station’s 3.0 primary and two multicast streams that are to be broadcast pursuant to this Application are to be broadcast on the technical facilities licensed to Television Station WPLG, FCC Facility ID Number 53113, also Miami, Florida. Both the Station and WPLG are assigned to the Miami-Fort Lauderdale Designated Market Area.

Specifically, for each hosted stream:

WSVN will multicast The Grio and THIS TV, as well as its primary FOX stream, in 1.0 on its own facility as well as in 3.0 on its host (WPLG) following the proposed 3.0 launch next month.
